## RAGBRAI STREET CLOSURES and PARKING

We realize this will be an inconvenience to the residents but in the interest of public safety and to aid in logistics of helping to get people to work and around town there will be some travel changes that will need to be kept in mind. Only Emergency vehicles or designated official vehicles will be allowed to travel on closed streets.

On Thursday, Highway 63 will be converted from a 4 lane to a 2 lane at or near Carleton Street in Toledo and continue 2 lanes until at or near 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Tama where it will change to a 3 lane and then back to a 4 lane when 63 turns east from Harding. The exit and entrance ramp from HWY 63 to HWY 30, Mile Marker 202, will be closed to all non-emergency traffic. All traffic will need to use the Tama Ramp at Mile Marker 204. The Exit at Mile Marker 201 is currently closed due to bridge construction.

Toledo, Thursday July 27, and Friday July 28<sup>th</sup> no access to HWY 63 from side streets south of High Street to Myrtle Street Except for Business 30, Ross Street and Marshall Street. Limited access on Ross Street from Hwy 63 west to Amwood Drive (Busses only or parking permit). Ross street will be closed from west street to the west to all non-event traffic to B street. Beginning Thursday morning local traffic from the area of B street will need to follow business 30 to the west, merge onto HWY 30 West bound and return to town on the east bound side and exit in Tama at the 204. Prospect Drive between Ross and High will be closed. Ross Street will reopen from B Street to the east about 8:00am July 28<sup>th</sup>. Amwood Drive will have limited event only traffic.

On Friday Early morning the IDOT will shut down HWY 63 to traffic from County Road E-69 to County Road E-29. They will reopen when bike traffic diminishes.

Parking shall not be allowed on the following streets in Toledo beginning on Thursday July 27<sup>th</sup> 8:00am until Friday July 28<sup>th</sup> at 12:00a.m. regardless of current signage, these streets will be utilized as bus routes to keep traffic moving safely the City will be changing the following streets to no parking during this time,

State between North West and Ann.  
North and South Broadway between West State and West Ross  
North and South West between West State and West Ross  
West Ross Between South Broadway and B Street  
Carleton between HWY 63 and Ann Street  
South Ann Between East Carleton and East State  
Amwood Drive  
Business 30  
Church Street from South City limits to Carleton  
Broadway from Business 30 to Summit  
Summit from South Broadway to South Church  
Main Street from West High to West Carleton

In Tama, Friday no access to Highway 63 from side streets except for the following intersections,

East 5<sup>th</sup>

Also, In Tama, the following streets shall be converted to no parking from Thursday July 27<sup>th</sup> at 8:00am until Friday July 28<sup>th</sup> at 12:00am.,

9<sup>th</sup> Street from Business 30 to Jackson

5<sup>th</sup> from Pershing to Siegel  
Siegel from 9<sup>th</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>

Mill from 2<sup>nd</sup> to McClellan  
McClellan from Mill to City Limits  
Washington from 13<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup>  
9<sup>th</sup> from Washington to Siegel  
South First from HWY 63 to Hall  
Hall from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>  
3<sup>rd</sup> from Siegel to HWY 63  
McClellan from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Country Club Drive

Anyone living in the area west of Country Club Drive will need to utilize 14<sup>th</sup> Street for their travel arrangements.

Friday as soon as it is deemed safe normal traffic flow will resume. The IDOT will be the ones closing the Highway 30 Ramps and Highway 63 and they will determine when to reopen them.

Anyone who has travel plans on Thursday or Friday or has appointments please keep the above times and closures in mind and decide accordingly. This will only be for a short time and everything will resume back to normal hopefully by mid-day on Friday.
